About Us

The Gettysburg Community Soup Kitchen has been a cornerstone for those in need of a nutritious meal for over 25 Years. The soup kitchen serves an average of 45 guests each day including both adults and children. With its roots in the church community, the soup kitchen family of meal sponsors and volunteers has grown to include many businesses, organizations, civic groups and social clubs. Members of our community have served with pride for more than 25 years. We appreciate all of these individuals and groups who play a significant role in our continued success and we are blessed to be the beneficiary of their gifts.

Our Daily Meal Program

We begin handing out meals at 11:15 AM and ending at 12:30 PM. An average of 45-60 guests are served Monday through Saturday. We serve a double meal Saturday to give our full-time staff a break on Sunday. Since 1991, our total meals served exceeds 300,000 with 15064 in 2020. Part of the 2020 total was 1143 Children served.

What a year! I came on as the new Board Chair in February 2020, just as the COVID-19 virus began to ravage our country. We had to quickly pivot how we implement our mission from one day to the next. The state mandated restrictions altered how we provide our normal service from an in-house meal to a take-out meal when lockdown started. As a necessity, food preparation and meal sponsor procedures along with volunteer and staff participation were subject to frequent changes. In a testament to the resiliency of our staff and board, we did not miss one day of supplying delicious nutritious hot meals to our guests, even under difficult conditions.

A huge part of our success was also due to the unprecedented generosity of our community. During the first months of the pandemic, we received generous donations from local businesses, churches, and individuals. A few donors sent in their entire stimulus checks to help us provide food to their hungry neighbors. Our continued participation in the annual ACCF Giving Spree resulted in another record year of donations that have allowed us to update some of our aging equipment and floors.

Finally, a huge thank you to everyone involved in continuing our mission of providing healthy meals to our guests. We look forward to resuming in-house dining as soon as we are able to safely manage our facility for our guests, staff, and volunteers.

A note from the Director of Operations

The best word I can think of to express 2020 at the soup kitchen is “WOW”! I am so grateful for the amazing things we have been able to accomplish. Despite the obstacles, restrictions and changes that had to be overcome in the past several months we were incredibly successful in providing food for the hungry in our community.

At the onset of the Pandemic the Soup Kitchen was able to transition overnight, maintain compliance with government mandated regulations, and provide take out meal service to our guests without missing a day. Starting March 17, 2020, our meals were all served in take-out containers. Our guests continue to be gracious and happy with the takeout meal process. Feedback has been very positive. Many guests remark how good the food is and how generous the portions are. While we are currently closed on Sundays, we provide one hot meal and one take along meal for Sunday on Saturdays.

In an effort to keep our social contact group to a minimum, we are not able to utilize more than a few volunteers. We are thankful that Churches, Civic Groups, Social Clubs and Individuals have continued to support the Soup Kitchen through generous monetary donations. Many of the groups provided the ingredients and supplies needed to prepare our meals in house. Some groups sponsored meals by purchasing from local restaurants. It was exciting to see these restaurants benefit at a time when they had decreased traffic. The outpouring of generosity has been nothing short of amazing.

The board approved many updates and renovations which include: a new convection oven, a food warming cabinet, a six-burner gas stove top, stainless steel worktables and storage units. Our Pantry received a much-needed update. We can now easily access food items from our new shelving units. The largest accomplishment by far is the completion of our beautiful new floors throughout the building. Our patience paid off in finding just the right flooring contractor for our needs. We are so very pleased with the outcome and the cost effectiveness of such a major project.

Ordinarily I would close by inviting folks to stop by and see what we do here at the Soup Kitchen. Unfortunately, we aren't ready to extend that invitation just yet. We look forward to having guests back inside for sit down meals.

Despite changes in routines, we have used our time wisely to improve our already awesome organization.

Finance Committee Report

In 2020, the Soup Kitchen, as well as the rest of the world faced a terrible pandemic. The protective measures we needed to take, to protect our guests, employees, and volunteers, required many changes. These adjustments had a financial cost that we had not anticipated. However, the wonderful outpouring of support, from so many, allowed us to continue providing food for the hungry in our community, and will allow us to continue that service for 2021.

The gifts we received were from businesses, individuals, churches, foundations, and grants. In-kind donations also made it possible for the Soup Kitchen to provide nutritious meals for our guests. Cash contributions helped with our other major expenses, which included, maintenance improvements, grocery purchases, payroll for our employees, and the cost of daily operations for the kitchen itself.

Our 2020 total income surpassed that of 2019. The funds we received from the Adams County Giving Spree was our single largest cash infusion in 2020. The faithful work of our great staff and wonderful volunteers makes the Soup Kitchen's presence in the Gettysburg area possible. The value of that work is beyond measure.

The Board has started a few major interior projects at the end of 2020 that will be completed at the beginning of 2021. Replacing the worn flooring, upgrading our stove, oven, and safety venting system. We will be financing these projects with funds received from the 2020 Giving Spree.

Our Board members are committed to making the operation of this great community service as efficient as possible. We started an endowment called the Friends of the Gettysburg Community Soup Kitchen that is managed by the Adams County Community Foundation. We are committed to continuing the great service and mission of the Soup Kitchen for many years to come.
